GAIL MARTIN MCKINNON The fall after we graduated from EHS I attended what was then Southwestern at Memphis, where I majored in English and graduated four years later as a member of Phi Beta Kappa. I moved to Little Rock, and after a brief advertising copy and working for KTHV, I began teaching in the Little Rock School District. To my delight, I found that I loved teaching and interacting with students. During my second year I, along with about nineteen other teachers from my district and some surrounding ones, was recruited by the State Department of Education to design the Arkansas Writing Project, an extremely reading and writing-intensive three-week course for teachers, a course based on all of the latest research on the teaching of writing. The teachers who took this course received six hours of graduate credit from Ouachita University. We taught the course in school districts all over the state for three summers. So successful was the course that we were invited to make a presentation at the National Council of Teachers of English in Philadelphia the following year. It was from this experience that I and the six teachers with me received what I consider one Arkansas education's greatest compliments: a professor from a prestigious Eastern college wrote a letter to the Arkansas Gazette saying, "When I saw a presentation from Arkansas as one the choices of workshops, I went to laugh and stayed learn." He went on to laud us, saying that he could not understand why Arkansas was not recognized in educational circles as one of the foremost states in the nation. That was fun! After three years of teaching, I took off a year off to get my M.A. in English and returned to Little Rock to teach Humanities and then senior Advanced Placement English. Introducing some of the world's greatest ideas and pieces of literature to eager learners (some more eager than others) proved so fascinating and so much fun that I kept teaching at Hall High School for 37 years until I retired. My amazement and delight at being invited by the College Board and Educational Testing Service to come to Princeton for one week and be one of about 200 college professors and high school teachers to score the essays on the SAT II were unimaginable. Even more amazing was that I was later invited to be one of the Assistant Chief Readers and finally to be the Chief Reader who oversaw the scoring of all the SAT II essays in the United States and from American schools all over the world, a position I held for five Readings (the maximum allowed). I also scored Advanced Placement essays as well as those on the PRAXIS and GRE. Two honors for which I was especially appreciative were winning for two different years the City Education Trust's Stephens Award for Outstanding Teachers in public and private schools in Little Rock. I must admit I really loved the five- thousand dollar stipend that each award carried with it. I am still reaping rewards of teaching, such as seeing one of my former students, David Auburn, receive both a Tony and Pulitzer Prized for his drama Proof. I have seen others go on to become published novelists, professional writers, doctors, lawyers –and sadly, a few convicted felons. You just can't win them all. My husband is Johnny McKinnon, the love of my life. He is also a retired educator and we are thoroughly enjoying our retirement as we read, travel, and play with our granddaughter in Austin, Texas.
